After much deliberation and prayerful consideration, your Oktoberfest team leaders have decided not to hold Oktoberfest this year. We do not feel we can offer a safe, socially-distant festival while being fiscally responsible.

This would have been our 10th Oktoberfest, and it's so disappointing, amongst a year of disappointments. It would also have been Pastor Emily's first official Oktoberfest.

Last year, Oktoberfest donated \$26,000, divided between the church, our renovation fund, our Youth Gathering fund, Lutheran Services Carolinas and our Scout Troop 8. We also paid off the original loan from the Foundation that got us started. Hopefully we can resume our work and these donations in 2021.

Oktoberfest has been a true ministry, both to ourselves and our community. I look forward to seeing how we can continue to serve in 2021!
