CHILDREN'S SERMON

FIRST READING: Acts 3:12-19

¹²[Peter] addressed the people, "You Israelites, why do you wonder at this, or why do you stare at us, as though by our own power or piety we had made him walk?¹³The God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, the God of our ancestors has glorified his servant Jesus, whom you handed over and rejected in the presence of Pilate, though he had decided to release him. ¹⁴But you rejected the Holy and Righteous One and asked to have a murderer given to you, ¹⁵and you killed the Author of life, whom God raised from the dead. To this we are witnesses. ¹⁶And by faith in his name, his name itself has made this man strong, whom you see and know; and the faith that is through Jesus has given him this perfect health in the presence of all of you. ¹⁷"And now, friends, I know that you acted in ignorance, as did also your rulers. ¹⁸In this way God fulfilled what he had foretold through all the prophets, that his Messiah would suffer. ¹⁹Repent therefore, and turn to God so that your sins may be wiped out."



forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. ⁴⁸You are witnesses of these things."


INVITATION TO COMMUNION


The risen Christ is made known to us in the breaking of the bread. Come and eat at God's table. **Thanks be to God.**



MORE JUSTICE

2024 Nehemiah Action Rally

As many of you know, the More Justice Nehemiah Action Rally occurred on Monday March 18, 2024. The event was held at Eau Claire High School. The three areas addressed during this rally included Gun Violence, Food Insecurities, and Affordable Housing.

- 650 community members of many faiths came together to Do Justice.
- 20 persons representing Incarnation Lutheran Church attended the Rally. Thank you. Thank you.
- The Office of Violent Crime Prevention has undertaken an assessment through the Community Action Fund. While we are still waiting for the results, we are hopeful that this is a strong assessment. More Justice will remain vigilant in our efforts to reduce gun violence.
- Columbia City Councilmembers Will Brennan and Tyler Baily have agreed to increase the number of service locations for the Mobile Market from 3 to 9 and to secure and allocate \$20,000 monthly for food security solutions.
- Richland County Council has put Affordable Housing on their strategic plan for 2024 and created a committee dedicated to using \$4M to increase our number of affordable housing units.

Come September 2024, we will begin the process all over again. More Justice can be achieved when we work together. **Incarnation Lutheran Church**
